

MANDATORY SELF DISCLOSURE CHECKLIST

Financial documents required pursuant to Supplemental Probate and Family Court Rule 410

Initial Disclosures (required for all divorces and all 209C proceedings)
 Federal and State tax returns: most recent three (3) years Pay Stubs: Four (4) most recent Health Insurance: documentation regarding the cost and nature of available coverage
Additional Disclosures (required upon written request from opposing party)
 Bank Statements: Three (3) years for all bank accounts held individually or jointly Investment Statements: Three (3) years for all retirement, stock, or other assets Mortgage Applications: any applications made, prepared or submitted in last three (3) years Statement of Assets and Liabilities: Any statements prepared within last three (3) years
Unavailability of Documents
If any of the required documents are not available or cannot be obtained in a timely fashion, the party must state in writing, under penalties of perjury:
